

John 14

- Q.: As Jesus speaks at the beginning of John 14 He combines words and thoughts from two important Jewish ceremonies. Passover is one. What is the other?
- Q.: Jesus says He goes to prepare a "place" for us. What 1st century cultural image does He project with these words? Compare this with the image Paul uses in 2 Corinthians 5:1-8.
- Q.: Compare Jesus' words in John 14:6 with Peter's words in Acts 4:12. Also see Paul's words in 1 Timothy 2:5. What definitive truth should we clearly understand from this?
- Q.: The ultimate test of our faith in Jesus and our love for the One Who has loved us so is our O______! See vs. 15, 21, and 23.
