


- Q.: As Jesus speaks at the beginning of John 14 He combines words and thoughts from two important Jewish ceremonies. Passover is one. What is the other?

- Q.: The ultimate test of our faith in Jesus and our love for the One Who has loved us so is our O ! See vs. 15, 21, and 23.






