Bible Challenge Questions For Palm Sunday, April 14, 2019 "The Day He Wore My Crown"

- Q.: Do we really realize and believe that the "Crown Jesus Wore" is one we should have worn? That the stripes He received were really ones we deserved? That the nails that pierced Him should have pierced us? That His Father's rejection- and the hell He experienced- is what we really deserve because of our sins?
