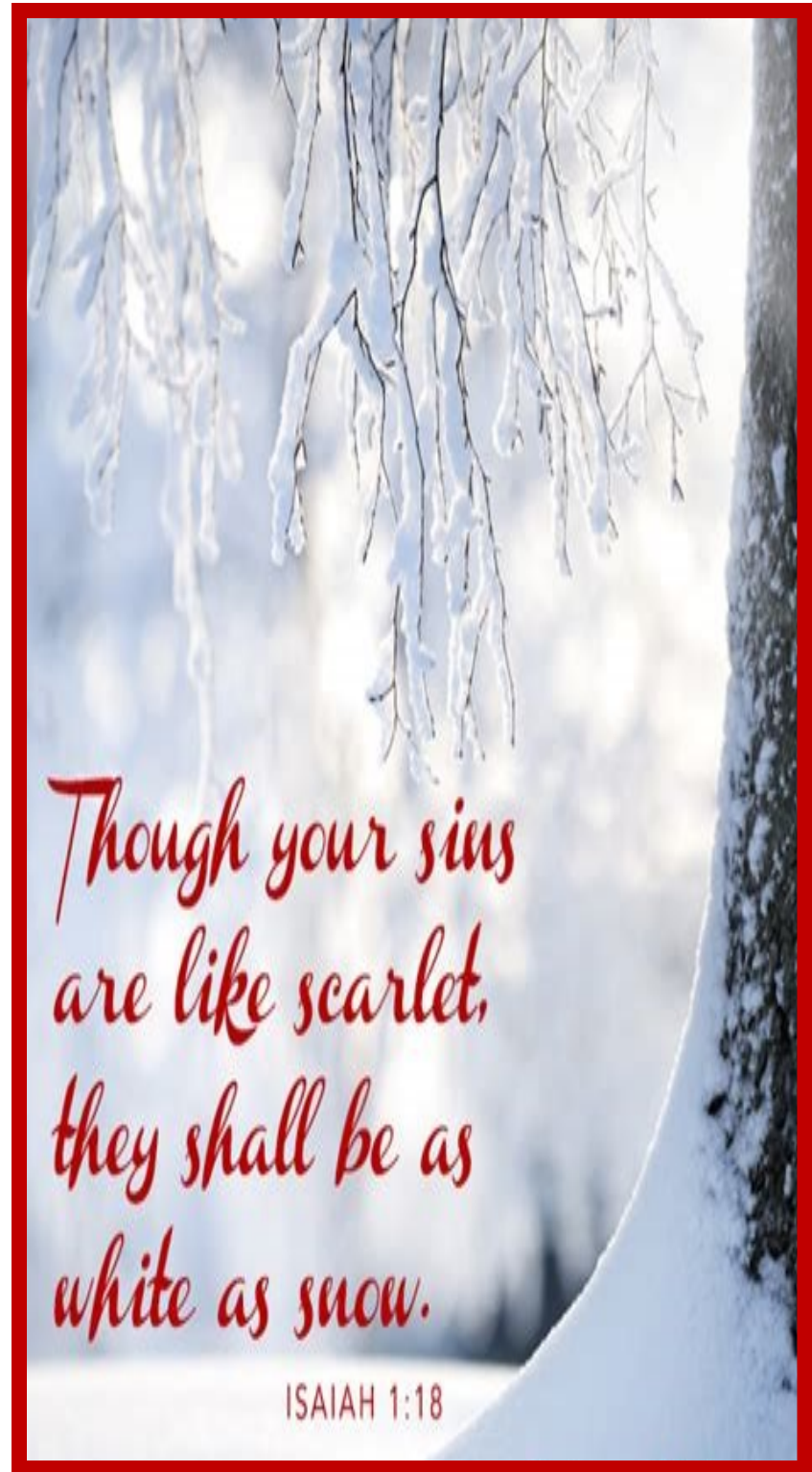

Sermon Notes

Bible Challenge

In The Name of God!
 John 8

Q.: John’s Gospel is all about Jesus and belief and eternal life (see Jn. 20:31 again). In John 8 we find the 2nd and 3rd of eight major “I AM” proclamations by the Lord Jesus (the first was in Jn. 6:35- “I AM the bread of life”). Look at the 2 found in chapter 8 verse 12 and verse 58. Also, checkout chapters 9,10, 11, and 14 to locate the others.

Q.: Actually, these major proclamations by Jesus are only 8 of a total of 30 statements He makes in this Gospel which all assert that He is indeed the True and Living God- (for a few examples see Jn. 4:26; 5:43; 8:28; 10:36; 18:5-6).

Q.: “I AM” is the name that God revealed Himself to Moses and the children of Israel as in Exodus 3:13-15 and also in 6:2-5. When Jesus proclaims that “Abraham saw His day (v.56-58) WHAT was the reaction of the Pharisees and WHY (v.59)? Remember also Jn. 5:17-18 and see also Jn. 10:31-33.

Q.: Jesus says in John 8 that people who perceive themselves as “free” can actually be enslaved in the worst of ways while those who are outwardly slaves may actually be made really free inwardly (vs. 31-36). What is OUR REAL STATUS, as Jesus, the True and Living God and Savior, sees us?
