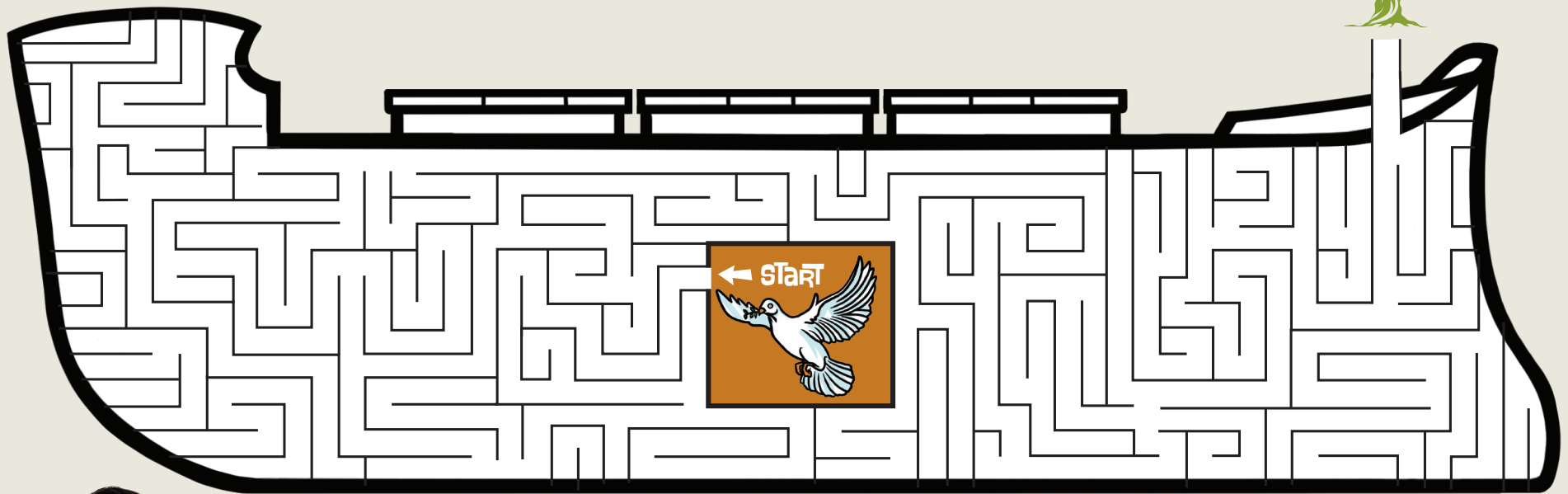

What You Heard *In the Word*

OutWord *For Family Discussion*

Suppose your friends are talking about Noah and the question comes up, “Why didn’t more people enter the Ark with Noah and his family? Why didn’t they listen to him?” **What would you say?**

The people of Noah’s day were very wicked. Their hearts were darkened by sin—they loved their sin and the world more than God, and they did not want to hear the truth Noah was preaching. People are really the same way today. Many people don’t care about the Bible or its truth. They don’t want to believe that Jesus is the only way to be forgiven of our sins and be saved. They just won’t listen. And everyone who turns away from Jesus Christ will be judged one day.
