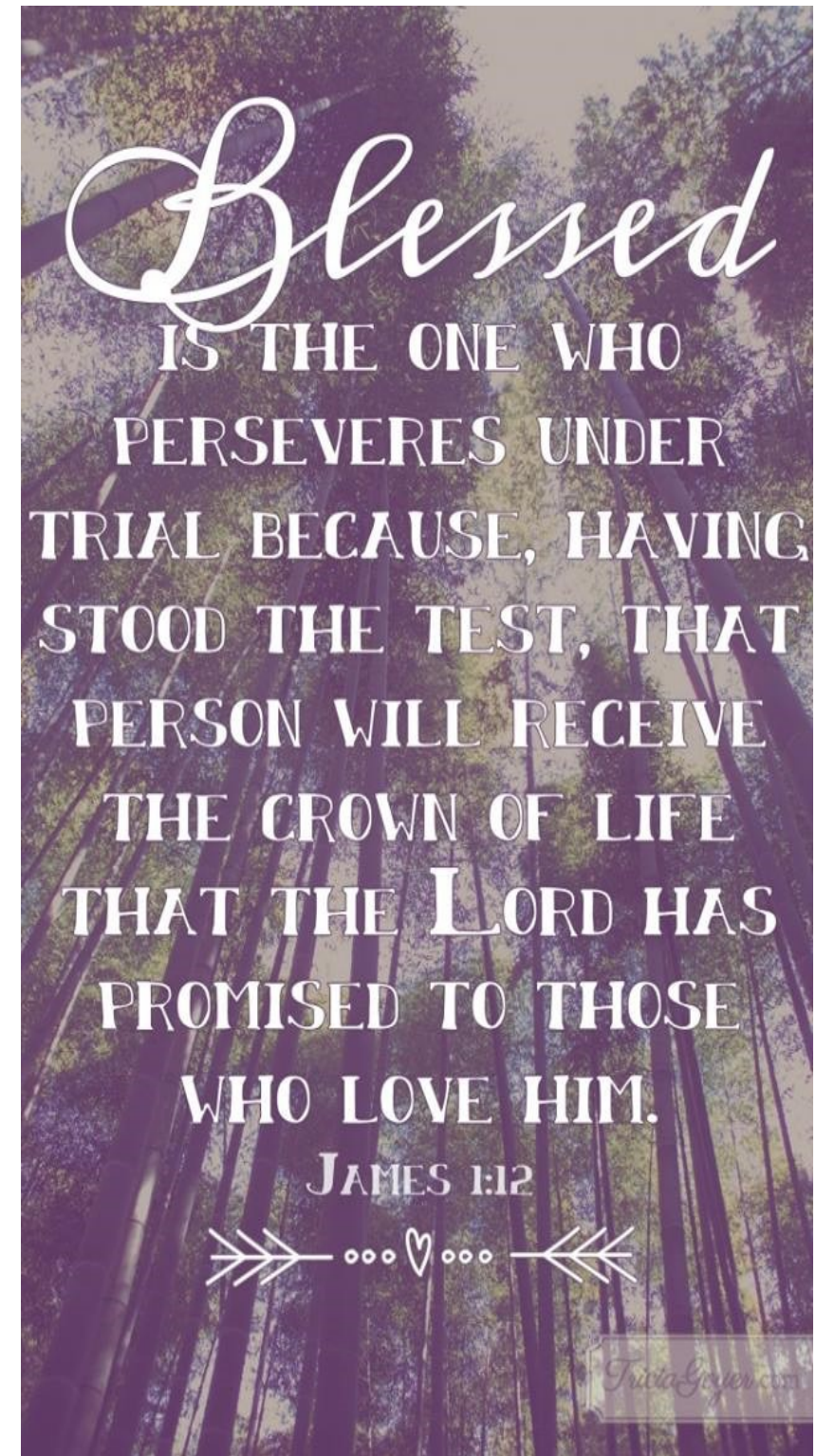

Dear Beloved,

As I write this letter I am in awe of what our Savior and Lord is doing in our midst. He is control and as saints of the most High God we can put our trust in Him in such a time is this. Even though we have been going through a “lockdown” God was never “locked down”.

God has given me yet another opportunity to serve Him. I have thoroughly enjoyed the Lord's time at the National 4H Youth Development Center these past 3 years. Many seeds have been planted and God has grown me as well. God has an abundant purpose for our lives.

So you may be asking what is going to be my “new normal”. Well, the Lord has opened the door for me to serve Him as principal of an elementary school grades k5 – 8 grade. This is a school that I had been wanting to serve at for quite some time, but, wanted the Lord to speak to the hearts of the school board without me saying anything to them.

Yep, you guessed it the Lord spoke and I was asked to be the principal of the Evangelical Mennonite Mission School (EMMC) in the Mennonite Colony of Spanish Lookout here in Belize. This is a people group that the Lord has drawn me to for several years and little by little God opened doors for me to serve in the EMMC church as a Children's Ministry Leader as well as a Jr. Youth leader.

So now every day I will be taking a 30 minute commute to school. We have about 90 students in the EMMC School. Many of whom I have built trust relationships with for the past 6 years. My goal is to continue to sow the seeds of our Lord in the hearts of the children so they can be the change in future generations to come.
