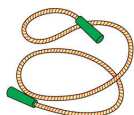

We also have the service streaming to the conference room (Room 205)

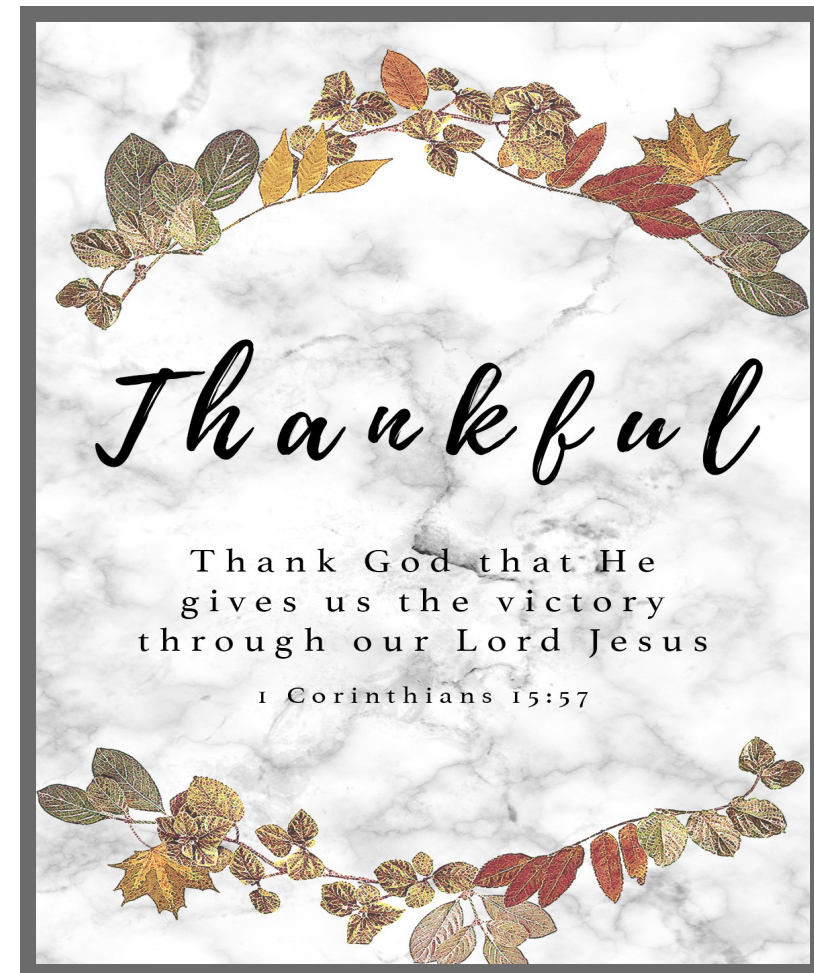
