## Missionary Minute - Grant and Deb Olson

"Grant and Deb Olson have had great news! The war in the Caspian came to a halt on November 20 and Caspian lands were returned after 40 years of occupation. Their two church plants, along with others in their network, have begun sending teams with truckloads of food, clothing, and Christian literature to the most needy families. They have been highlighted on national TV with interviews! The government began supporting the work as they are eager to show it was a war about land and not religion. The Olsons are grateful for this new opportunity to bring the Gospel to needy people in full support and blessing from the government. The church continues to grow. A woman named Tamella began visiting one of the churches recently and put her faith in Christ.

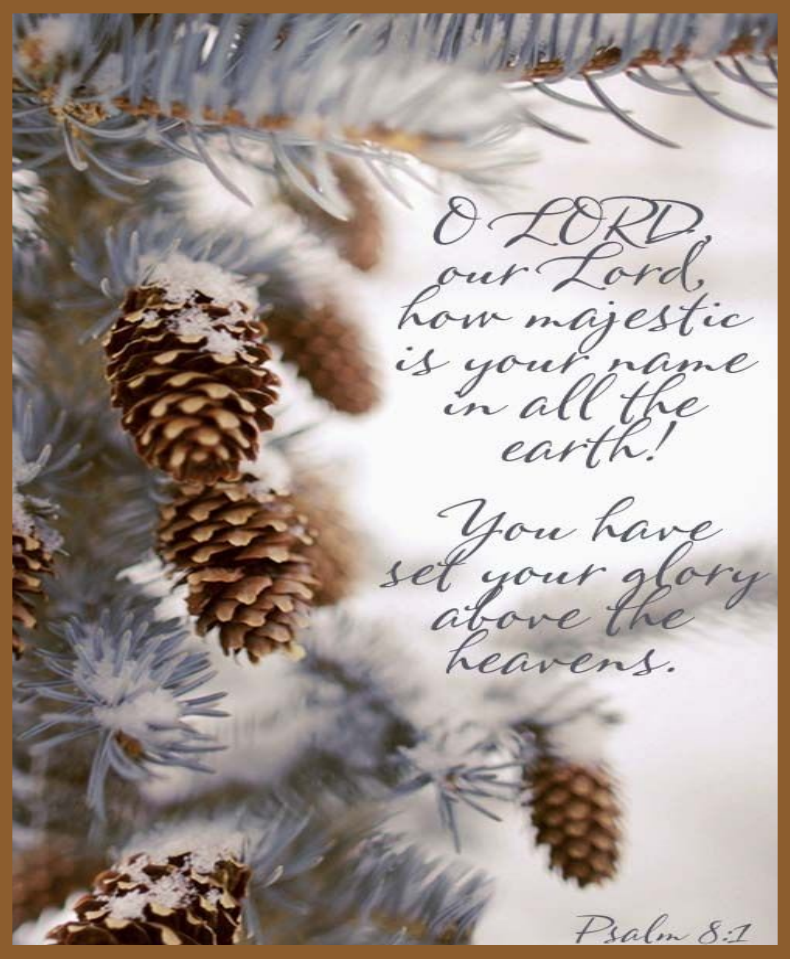
In 2021 they'll continue working from the US to spearhead special projects to help build church planting capacity (e.g. theological education for local church leaders, relief aid to help church planters gain access to rural areas, and mobilizing people and resources as the work expands).
